

10 REASONS WHY PENNSYLVANIA NEEDS A NEW CONSTITUTION

1. Reduce the size of bloated state government by eliminating the state Senate, and cutting the state House to 105 members.
2. To provide real tax relief by allowing taxes to be graduated according to a citizen's ability to pay.
3. Make government at all levels accountable through term limits.
4. Eliminate costly and unnecessary positions of elected county officials.
5. Place the burden and cost of running the judicial system in Harrisburg, where it belongs.

9. Bring to Pennsylvania's citizens the modern democratic tools of initiative, referendum, and recall.
10. Ensure that our constitution remains relevant in changing times, by restoring the automatic and periodic review of it, as was provided for originally.
