#### MARCH 6 th RALLY DETAILS

In case you haven't heard.....our Members of Congress ( Dent, Costello, Meehan, and Smucker) have found the time to meet with Chamber of Commerce members on Monday, March 6 th. The event is billed as the Chamber of Congress, " Congressional Conversation 2017". It is scheduled for March 6, from 3-5 PM, at the Doubletree by Hilton Hotel, 701 Penn Street, Reading. Many of us have been standing out in the cold in front of district offices or dealing with busy phone signals, trying to contact our elected officials. Now is our chance to have our voices heard.

The Doubletree is located at 701 Penn Street, between 6th and 8th streets. The Doubletree is across the street from the Santander arena so there are parking structures nearby and wide sidewalks to accommodate us.
